

PaniqueniansUSA, Inc

Scholarship Criteria – School Year 2009 - 2010

1. Applicant must be attending senior year or has graduated from high school in the year 2009.
2. The applicant must be a Paniquenian descent (at least one of the parents/grandparents is a Paniquenian) and parents must be a registered member of the *PaniqueniansUSA, Inc.*
3. Each applicant must complete the *PaniqueniansUSA, Inc.* Scholarship Application.
4. Minimum GPA of 3.25
5. Applications will be reviewed on the basis of:
 - Grades
 - Education history and community involvement
 - Applicant's demonstration of commitment to the PaniqueniansUSA, Inc.
6. The *PaniqueniansUSA, Inc.* scholarship committee will make the selection of the scholarship recipient(s), and its decision shall be final.
7. The *Paniquenians USA, Inc.* has allocated \$3,000 for the school year 2009–2010 US Scholarship Program. However, the continuance of the program and the annual funding may vary in future years depending on the financial capability of the association. (Please note that the association has been consistent and successful in sponsoring a similar scholarship program in Paniqui, Tarlac, Philippines over the past 20 years.)

The allocated amount will be divided equally among the qualifying candidates, but not to exceed \$500 per candidate.
8. Completed applications and attachments must be received between July and October 2009.
9. Awarding of scholarship will be in December 2009 at the association's Christmas party.
